<u>Subject:</u> Abnormal delay in making necessary arrangements for DOT to take over the task of disbursement of pension and pensionary benefits to combined service pension optees MTNL employees.

Sir

In spite of govt decision to pay pension to MTNL absorbed employees who opted for combined service pension vide its gazette notification (E) GSR 138 (E) dated 03-03-2014 and DOT OM No 42-4/2012 –Pen (T) dated 28-04-2014, PPO have not still been issued by DOT because making of necessary arrangements for DOT to take over the task of disbursement of the pension is getting inordinately delayed as MTNL could not provide to the concerned unit of DOT an adequate number of working hands as well as the office accommodation with required infrastructure not only that request of DOT to provide one CAO and two AOs on deputation basis to DOT could not be complied with by MTNL so far. As a result of this the target set to prepare and issue PPO books by DOT at least for the retirees superannuated from 30th April 2014 and onward could not be achieved.

Because of delay in issuance of PPO books all other post retirement benefits are also getting delayed even the medical benefits and retention of telephone connection are linked with the PPO books. So, your good self can very well understand how important the PPO book is for retired employees.

We, therefore request your good self to take necessary actions to ensure early issuance of PPO books by DOT. And till the DOT issues PPO books, kindly take following action to redress the grievances of the retired employees.

1. Payment of earned leave encashment

- 2. Refund of insurance amount
- Implementation of Corporate office orders by Delhi & Mumbai Unit to issue temporary indoor medical cards
- 4. Payment of commutated pension
- 5. Order not to disconnect the telephone connection extended for two months till PPOs are issued

6. Timely payment of pension.
